The 2014 Women's Arboriculture Conference Student Video Contest highlights videos from a variety of disciplines addressing trees, their place in our world and our relationship with them.

Contest winners receive a full conference pass* for the March 5-7 Women's Arboriculture Conference held at Harrison Hot Springs Resort! Deadline for video submissions extended until February 14, 2014.

Eligible students are currently enrolled* in a certificate, diploma, or degree program in a Canadian or American institution, in one or more of the following fields: arboriculture, horticulture, permaculture, urban or regional planning, architecture, landscape architecture or design, counselling, or forestry. Proof of enrollment and status will be required prior to the contest winner being declared.

Contest details:

- submit a short video (maximum two minutes in length) answering one of the three questions
 - 1. What issue, related to trees in urban environments are you most passionate about? What is one of your ideas to work towards problem solving this issue?
 - 2. Why do you think an interdisciplinary conference is a valuable experience to be a part of? Share an example of an interdisciplinary project that you have worked on and how this environment enriched your learning experience.
 - 3. What does it mean to you to focus passion, policy, and planning on trees?
- In your video, include the following images:
 - a) The Women's Arboriculture Conference logo at the beginning
 - b) Logos of Presenting and Sitka Spruce sponsors at the end Presenting sponsors are: Mumby's Arboriculture Consulting and Kwantlen Polytechnic University. - Winners receive a conference pass. Travel and accommodation are not included. *If the winner is a full-time student, a full pass will be awarded, a \$325.50 value, and if parttime, a 50% discount, a \$162.75 value.
